

The Threat of Radical Islam: A Working Bibliography

Ajami, Fouad, *The Foreigner's Gift*. Simon & Schuster, 2006. A study of the US involvement with Iraq, with key lessons for understanding the Middle East and the Islamic community.

Ali, Ayaan Hirsi, *The Caged Virgin*. Simon & Schuster, 2006. A collection of the author's activist writings while in the Netherlands. Includes the text of the short documentary "Submission".

Ali, Ayaan Hirsi, *Infidel*. Free Press, 2007. An incredible autobiography of a indomitable woman who was raised in strict Islam, defected to the Netherlands, fought for women's rights, was elected to parliament, then because of the Dutch government's inability to protect her came to the U.S. to carry on the fight against Islam, especially its harsh treatment of women.

Archangel Group, *Terror at Beslan: A Russian Tragedy with Lessons for America's Schools*. Archangel Group, 2005. A history of the Chechen Islamic war against Russia and a chronicle of the Islamic inspired terrorist hostage event at Beslan Middle School in September 2004. The book focuses on the difficulty of engaging and defeating religious inspired attacks against civilians. It contains valuable advice and warnings for US schools, malls and other large concentrations against this form of threat.

Armstrong, Karen, *Muhammad: A Biography of the Prophet*. Harper Collins, 1993: The author received the 1999 Muslim Public Affairs Media Award for her favorable treatment of early Islam. Critics believe she downplays the less commendable aspects of the Prophet's career.

Babbin, Jed, *In the Words of our Enemies*. Washington: Regnery, 2007. A thorough account of the actual words of Islamic terrorist leaders as they fan the flames of anti-Western hatred.

Bawer, Bruce, *While Europe Slept*. Doubleday, 2006. Details how Islam is destroying the West from within.

Berlinsky, Claire, *Menace in Europe: Why the Continent's Crisis is America's Too*. Crown Forum, 2006, with deep knowledge and fresh insight, Berlinski discusses how some of the problems swirling in Europe (nihilism & neo-Nazism) echo patterns of the distant past.

Bostom, Andrew G., editor, *The Legacy of Jihad, Islamic Holy War and the Fate of Non-Muslims*. Prometheus Books, 2005: In eight compelling sections, Bostom's collection depicts Islam's justification for jihad and its worldwide impact that extended over thirteen centuries of war, reproducing quotations from the Qur'an and the Hadith.

Davis, Gregory, *Religion of Peace? Islam's War Against the World*. Midpoint Trade Books, 2006. The author demonstrates that Islam is a violent, expansionary

ideology more akin to a governmental system than a personal religious faith. The Qur'an, believed by Muslims to contain the words of God verbatim, constitutes a vivid message to kill unbelievers and conquer the territories they inhabit.

Emerson, Steven, *American Jihad: The Terrorists Living Among Us*. Simon & Schuster, 2003. The author is widely recognized as America's foremost independent investigative expert on Islamic terrorism.

Emerson Steven, *Jihad Inc.: A Guide to Militant Islam in the United States*. Prometheus Books, 2006. An informative look into the infiltration of Islamic terrorism into the US both before and after 9/11.

Esposito, John, *The Islamic Threat: Myth or Reality?* Oxford University Press, 1999. "Offers a valuable history of the leading figures and movements in the 20th Century Islamic revival, underlining the trend in recent years away from violence and toward parliamentary practices." (*NY Times*). Esposito's scholarship may be compromised by his ties to Saudi funding at Georgetown University.

Fallaci, Oriana, *The Force of Reason*. Rizzoli Publications, 2006. The heroic struggle of one individual dedicated to awakening Europe to the Islamic threat.

Fregosi, Paul. *Jihad in the West; Muslim Conquests from the 7th to the 21st Centuries*. Prometheus Books, 1998. Factual accounts of repeated Islamic military invasions of Europe - the most neglected and disregarded phenomenon in European history.

Gabriel, Brigitte, *Because They Hate: A Survivor of Islamic Terror Warns America*. St. Martin's Press, 2006. The terrifying story of a Lebanese Christian family held hostage by jihadis for seven years, with a warning to America to understand and do battle with the threat of jihad.

Gerges, Fawaz A., *America and Political Islam: A Clash of Cultures*. Cambridge University Press, 1999. A comprehensive account of the origins of American policy toward political Islam.

Gerges, Fawaz, *The Far Enemy: Why Jihad Went Global*. Cambridge University Press, 2005. The author unravels the story of how the jihadist movement came to target the "far enemy" (the West) instead of "the near enemy" (Middle East secular governments).

Gerges Fawaz, *Journey of the Jihadist: Inside Muslim Militancy*. Harcourt, 2006. A journalist interviews jihadis to find what makes them willing to die for Islam.

Gabriel, Mark A., *Islam and Terrorism*. Charisma House, 2002: What the Qur'an really teaches about Christianity, violence and the goals of the Islamic jihad. The author is a former professor of Islamic history at Al-Azhar University, Cairo, Egypt.

Gerges, Fawaz, *Journey into the Mind of an Islamic Terrorist*. Charisma House, 2006. Why jihadis hate us and how we can change their minds.

Gold, Dore, *Hatred's Kingdom: How Saudi Arabia Supports the New Global Terrorism*. Regnery, 2003. Presents shocking, never-before-seen evidence of how the Saudis have financed the world's most dangerous terrorist organizations.

Habeck, Mary, *Knowing the Enemy: Jihadist Ideology and the War on Terror*. New Haven CT: Yale University Press, 2006. The author studies the texts and proclamations of jihadi leaders to lay the groundwork for an effective anti-terrorist program.

Harris, Lee, *The Suicide of Reason: Radical Islam's Threat to the West*. Basic Books, 2007. Harris argues that the liberal West, whose political theories are based on the Enlightenment, are unfamiliar with mass fanaticism of Islam. He suggests how the West can counter this – if it moves swiftly.

Ibrahim, Raymond, *The Al Qaeda Reader*. Doubleday, 2007. A Library of Congress expert presents the actual sayings of Al Qaeda leaders, making clear that their goal is to convert the world to Islam, force nonbelievers to live as dhimmi, or kill them. Perhaps the most disturbing aspect of these works is how grounded they are in the traditional sources of Islamic theology, evidence that dismisses the myth of "hijacking."

Iklé, Fred C., *Annihilation from Within: the Ultimate Threat to Nations*. Columbia University Press, 2006. A former U.S. defense official analyzes Islamic penetration as the ultimate threat to nations.

Karsh, Efraim, *Islamic Imperialism*. Yale University Press, 2006. A scholarly but readable history of Muslim expansionism from the time of the Prophet to Osama bin Laden.

Kushner, Harvey with Bart Davis, *Holy War on the Home Front: The Secret Islamic Terror Network in the US*. Sentinel Books, 2004. This book reveals the Islamic extremist fifth column; a highly organized underground army whose tentacles reach throughout the US society to recruit converts from mosques to prisons.

Lewis, Bernard, *What Went Wrong? The Clash Between Islam and Modernity in the Middle East*. Oxford University Press, 2002. One of the West's most distinguished historians shines a floodlight on the cruel divide between the West and the societies of Islam.

Lewis, Bernard, *The Crisis of Islam: Holy War and Unholy Terror*. Random House, 2004. Lewis examines the historical roots of the resentments that dominate the Islamic world today and that are being increasingly expressed in acts of terrorism.

Minter, Richard, *Losing Bin Laden: How Bill Clinton's Failures Unleashed Global Terror*. Washington: Regnery, 2004: This book exposes how President Clinton stymied the FBI and the CIA and refused to wage a real war against bin Laden's growing terrorism.

Minter, Richard, *Shadow War: The Untold Story of How Bush is Winning the War on Terror*. Washington: Regnery, 2004. This book describes how the Bush Administration set out to counter Islamic terrorism.

Minter Richard, *Disinformation: 22 Media Myths that Undermine the War on Terror*. Washington: Regnery, 2005. Minter discusses and refutes 22 myths about the war in Iraq, terrorism and al Qaeda.

Pape, Robert A., *Dying to Win, the Strategic Logic of Suicide Terrorism*. Random House, 2005. This book explores the most chilling and perhaps most challenging feature

of our new strategic environment, suicide terrorism.

Peters, Ralph, *Wars of Blood and Faith*. Stackpole Books, 2007. Col. Peters argues that we have left behind the "age of ideologies" to enter a violent period in which ethnicity and religion will continue to be the source of rebellions, genocide, and global terrorism.

Phillips, Melanie, *Londonistan*. Encounter Books (USA), 2006. Phillips outlines the demise of the Western Europe under the Muslim immigration onslaught. She chronicles how "Londonistan" developed as a result of the collapse of British self-confidence and its resulting paralysis by multiculturalism and appeasement.

Pipes, Daniel, *In the Path of God: Islam and Political Power*. Basic Books, 1983 (first edition). The book was written in response to the 1979 Iranian revolution and hostage crisis. It presents an overview of the historical significance of a militant interpretation of Islam.

Pipes Daniel, *Militant Islam Reaches America*. W.W. Norton, 2003. This is the product of 30 years of research and is "one of the most vital books about the grave issues that now confront America".

Podhoretz, Norman, *World War IV: The Long Struggle Against Islamofascism*. Doubleday, 2007. A leading neoconservative argues that the West is locked in a long struggle against radical Islam, and that democratization of Muslim regimes is "the only viable challenge to terrorism".

Richardson, Joel, *Antichrist: Islam's Awaited Messiah*. Pleasant Word, 2006. Presents a comprehensive and well researched comparison of the "end times" according to both Christian and Muslim prophesy.

Ryan, Kevin J., *Radical Eye for the Infidel Guy*. Prometheus Books, 2007. Irreverent satirical explanation of the glories of the Qu'ran and Islam, such as its "amputation-friendly criminal justice system".

Shoebat, Walid, *Why I Left Jihad: The Root of Terrorism and the Return of Radical Islam*. Top Executive Media, 2005. The author is a former PLO member who was inducted into terrorist activities as a juvenile. He immigrated to the West after spending time in an Israeli jail, and converted to Christianity while trying to convert his wife to Islam. The book delves into theology, history, and prophesy.

Shultz, Jr., Richard H. & Andrea J. Dew, *Insurgents, Terrorists, and Militias: The Warriors of Contemporary Combat*. Columbia University Press, 2006. A thorough assessment of unconventional warriors of modern combat and how to rethink asymmetrical war planning.

Spencer, Robert, *Onward Muslim Soldiers, How Jihad Still Threatens America and the West*. Washington: Regnery, 2003. A realistic and therefore disturbing assessment of the greatest threat to civilized life in this century.

Spencer Robert, *Islam Unveiled: Disturbing Questions About the World's Fastest-Growing Faith*. Encounter Books, 2003. A carefully researched book that asks hard questions about Islam and gives hard answers, providing a needed antidote to the wishful distortions that have swamped the media since 9-11.

Spencer, Robert, *The Politically Incorrect Guide to Islam (and the Crusades)*. Washington: Regnery, 2005. Muhammad did not teach "peace and tolerance"; he led armies and ordered the assassination of his enemies. The jihad continues today; Europe could be Islamic by the end of the 21st century.

Spencer Robert, *The Myth of Islamic Tolerance: How Islamic Law Threatens Non-Muslims*. Prometheus Books, 2005. A collection of essays by some of the world's leading authorities on Islamic social history. Focuses on the pervasive legal and cultural oppression of non-Muslims in Islamic countries.

Spencer, Robert, *Religion of Peace? Why Christianity Is and Islam Isn't*. Washington: Regnery, 2007. Spencer defends our Judeo-Christian heritage as the true religion of peace, and calls for an alliance of secular Muslims and all non-Muslim faiths (including atheists) to strengthen an enlightened counter to the Qur'an.

Spencer, Robert, *The Truth About Muhammad: Founder of the World's Most Intolerant Religion*. Washington: Regency, 2007. The author relies exclusively on Islamic sources to expose that for 1400 years, the words and deeds of Muhammad have been moving Muslims to commit acts of violence.

Sperry, Paul, *Infiltration: How Muslim Spies and Subversives Have Penetrated Washington*. Nelson Current, 2005. An investigative report on the infiltration of radical Muslim influence into American mosques, nonprofits, prisons, government agencies, and even the White House. The book offers a ten point plan for thwarting this penetration: tighten up on radical mosques, enforce the oath of allegiance, profile Muslim travelers, audit Muslim charities, break ties with CAIR, expose the Saudi embassy, deny security clearance to Muslim activists, offer scholarships in Arabic, fight Muslim activism in public schools, step up counterterrorism training.

Steyn, Mark, *America Alone: The End of the World as We Know It*. Washington: Regnery, 2006. A study on the key threats from Islam and the continuing inability of the West to counter their effects. The author's position is that since anti-Americanism fuels both Old Europe and radical Islam, America will have to stand alone.

Timmerman, Kenneth R., *Preachers of Hate: Islam and the War on America*. Crown Publishing, 2003. This book uncovers the ancient hatred that threatens the life and livelihood of every American - the "new" anti-Semitism that target Jews, Americans and the West.

Trifkovic, Serge, *The Sword of the Prophet: A Politically Incorrect Guide to Islam*. Regina Orthodox Press, 2002. An accurate history of Islam's effect on our world beginning with the Prophet himself. The author completely debunks the myth of a "peaceful and tolerant" Islam that has been hijacked by militant jihadis.

Trifkovic, Serge, *Defeating Jihad: How the War on Terror May Yet be Won, In Spite of Ourselves*. Regina Orthodox Press, 2006. A thorough explanation of the Qur'an and Islam, and the steps America must take to survive the onslaught of Muslim true believers.

Warren, IBM, *Why I Am Not a Muslim*. Prometheus Books, 2003 (orig. 1995). This book is "The Philosopher's Stone" for Muslims considering apostasy as well an accurate

journey into Islam for non-Muslims. This is a wake-up call that too many Americans still do not want to hear.

Warraq, Ibn, ed. *Leaving Islam: Apostates Speak Out*. Prometheus Books, 2003. Islamic apostates tell their own stories of their various journeys toward enlightenment.

Weigel, George, *Faith, Reason and the War Against Jihadism*. Doubleday Random House, 2007. The author explains the forward thrust of jihad, and how it may be countered, notably by reducing our petroleum dependency.

Wright, Lawrence, "The Master Plan: For the New Theorists of Jihad, Al Qaeda is just the Beginning." *The New Yorker*, September 11, 2006. A widely read analysis of Al Qaeda's thinking and its plans for the subjugation and destruction of the Dar al Harb.

Ye'Or, Bat, *Islam and Dhimmitude: Where Civilizations Collide*. Fairleigh Dickinson University Press, 2005. This is a fascinating and historically accurate account of the age-old hatred and persecution of Christians and Jews as ordained by the Qur'an and Islamic Sharia law. Ye'Or *elucidates* how the doctrinal patterns of subjugation of the dhimmi peoples (i.e., Christians and Jews) initiated during the Arab and Turkish waves of Islamic conquest are of immediate relevance to contemporary historical trends and current events.

Ye' Or Bat, *Eurabia: The Euro-Arab Axis*. Fairleigh Dickinson University Press, 2005. Portrays Western Europe's recrudescing dhimmitude, chronicled in real time. Describes in painstaking detail the ongoing transformation of Europe into "Eurabia," a cultural and political appendage of the Arab/Muslim world.
